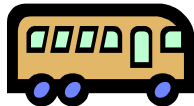


Holy Trinity Elementary

YC Choir

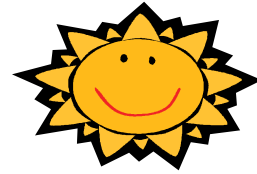
The choirs final performance of the year will be at the 11:30 Mass at SSMJ Sunday, June 6th.
