TOPS

- Dress shirts or polo shirts with turned down collars and sleeves.
- Shirt colors include: solid navy or solid white. Solid royal blue will be allowed if purchased with approved HTC logo.
- NO logo or label showing on the shirt is allowed with the exception of the HTC logo.
- Shirts must be tucked into pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts for grades 7-12.
- Sweaters: solid navy, gray, or white cardigans, pullovers, fleece, v-neck, 3/4 zip pullovers, and sweater vests may be worn over an approved shirt with collar showing. No logo or label to be shown except for the HTC approved logos.
- Sweatshirts: solid navy, gray, or royal blue sweatshirts or hoodies with approved HTC logo, worn over approved shirt with collar.

BOTTOMS

- Boys must wear tan, khaki, or navy blue pants.
- Girls must wear tan, khaki or navy blue pants, skirts, skorts, or jumpers.
- Girls may also wear the school approved plaid for skorts, skirts, and jumpers. The plaid is "clear blue" from www.landsend.com.
- **Boys and girls are allowed to wear shorts during summer dress code season: first day of school - October 15th and from May 1st until the end of the school year.**
- Shorts for boys and girls must be no shorter than either 4 inches above the knee or fingertip length with arms extended.
- The same length policies apply for skirts, skorts, and jumpers.
- Tights, knee high socks, and solid leggings in navy, tan, khaki, gray, or white may be worn under the dress code clothing items.

OTHER

- Shoes: closed toe shoes with socks are required. Tennis shoes are recommended for elementary students.
- Belts are required for pants, skirts, and skorts that have belt loops for all 7th - 12th grade students.
- Scarves, ties, belts, and socks of students' choice should be in good taste.

NOT ALLOWED:

- Attire promoting racial or religious intolerance, gangs, violence, sexism, vulgar and inappropriate language, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products is strictly prohibited.
- No midriff or cleavage showing.
- No torn or cut off pants, shorts, or shirts.
- No dresses unless announced by administration.
- No caps/hats and other headwear in the schools during the school day.
- No denim, wind suits, slicks, sweat pants, stretch pants, or bib overalls.
- No shirts worn inside-out.

STANDARDS OF PERSONAL APPEARANCE

- Hair styles must be clean and well-groomed. May not be of an extreme nature as to cause undue attention or cause a class disruption.
- Hair color needs to be a shade that is naturally occurring to humans; no purple, blue, etc. except when approved by administration for a special event. Color used at a special event will be temporary and easily washed out.
- Visible pierced jewelry may be in the ear only and not at such an extreme nature as to cause undue attention to the person or to cause a class disruption.
- Gentlemen must be clean shaven.
- Tattoos are strongly discouraged. If a student is competing in a school event for sports, cheerleading, fine arts, etc. tattoos must be covered.

DRESS DOWN DAYS

- Administration will announce pre-approved dress down days, whereby students are given the opportunity for choice of clothing.
- Clothing must be appropriate and in good taste. No shorts are allowed for dress down days unless during designated summer dress code season.
