It's that time of year – the annual student auction sponsored by the High School Student Council. HTC students bid on items that are donated by the parents, local businesses and the students themselves. The money raised at the auction is used for a variety of things at the Jr./Sr. High. In the past, the Student Council has been able to purchase the electronic sign in front of the school, bike racks, outdoor trash cans (that look nice) and much more. Last year our auction raised a little over \$7,000 and this year we hope to top that mark.

High school students will be able to bid during a live auction, as well as a silent auction throughout the day on Wednesday. The average spent at last year's auction was \$50 per student although some spend less and some spend much more. Talk to your child about how much they can spend before that day. Please fill out the auction permission slip below and return to the school by Monday, Feb. 14th.

We are looking for items for both the junior high and high school auctions. Please bring all auction items to the school by Monday, Feb.14th. Items will be accepted up to the time of the auction but the sooner the better so that we are able to get organized before the event. If you would like to donate a party or trip, please bring a poster listing all of the details. Contact Mrs. Mueller ahead of time and one of the students can make a poster for you. A list of possible items can be found on the next page, but feel free to be creative with your ideas. Remember that we need items for both the live auction and the silent auctions so besides larger items, we need smaller things like candy bars, trinkets, etc., for the silent auction.

Food items will also be accepted and are encouraged. Because the auction will run through lunch time, we will need plenty of food for the auction - this can include breakfast items such as donuts, breakfast pizza, and chocolate milk, as well as lunch items like pizza, subs, Mexican food, Chinese food, etc. Please bring all food-related items the day of the auction. Also, please submit the food form to assist with the purchasing of food by Monday, Feb. 14th. Students will either need to purchase lunch at the auction or bring their lunch, as no school lunch will be provided.
