

HTC Student Auction
Wednesday, February 16th, 2022
Junior High School Form

It's that time of year – the annual student auction sponsored by the high school student council. HTC students bid on items donated by the parents, local businesses, and the students themselves to raise money for the stewardship check presented to the school. Last year our auction raised a little over \$7,000 and this year we hope to top that mark.

The junior high school students will have a slightly different schedule from the high school. They will have the opportunity to play bingo in 45-minute increments – they will get one free card and then it will be \$2 per additional card for the entire 45 minutes. Students can also buy as many cards as they want. Prizes (donated by students, parents, and others) will be given to the winners. At the same time, the silent auction will be going on. At the end of bingo, they will auction off a few bigger items for the students to bid on. Junior high students are required to have a limit set by their parents to help control spending. The average spent at last year's auction was \$50 per student. Talk to your child about how much they can spend before that day. Please fill out the auction permission slip below and return to the school by Monday, February 14th.

We are looking for items for both the junior high and high school auctions. If you have a preference as to which auction you want your item(s) on, please clearly mark it on the item so we can get it in the right place. Please bring all auction items to the school by Monday, February 14th. Items will be accepted up to the time of the auction, but the sooner the better so that we are able to get organized before the event. If you would like to donate a party or trip, please bring a poster listing all of the details or you can contact Mrs. Mueller ahead of time and one of the students can make a poster for you. A list of possible items can be found on the next page, but feel free to be creative with your ideas. Remember that we need items for both the live auction and silent auctions, so besides larger items, we need smaller things like candy bars, trinkets, etc., for the silent auction.

Food items will also be accepted and are encouraged. Because the auction will run through lunch time, we will need plenty of food for the auction - this can include breakfast items such as donuts, breakfast pizza, and chocolate milk, as well as lunch items like pizza, subs, Mexican food, Chinese food, etc. Please bring all food-related items the day of the auction. Also, please submit the food form to assist with the purchasing of food by Monday, February 14th. Students will either need to purchase lunch at the auction or bring their lunch, as no school lunch will be provided.
