Students grades 7th through 12th will be participating in our annual Lend-A-Student day to raise money to participate in stewardship projects throughout the year. Our main focus of this project is to support our fall festivals with a monetary donation presented by the HTC High School Student Council.

Regulations for the Day:

- Students are to work from 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM. This includes a ½ hour lunch break.
- The price per student worker is \$45 (**checks payable to HTC High School Student Council**)
- Students will be under the supervision of the adult supervisor they have signed up to work for on this day.
- Money will be collected and turned into the office no later than one week from the Lend-A-Student Day. You may turn in your money early to the office.
- No student will be allowed to work alone unless it is a relative or has been approved by the Student Council Advisor.
- This event will proceed no matter rain or shine.
- Students that do not have a placement will report to school by 8:15 and will have jobs secured at the school for them.
- Students that are at school for the day will be provided lunch by the Student Council Advisor.
- **Students that have class outside of HTC are expected to attend their classes. If they do not attend, it will be an unexcused absence. (\$5 will be deducted from the fee for each hour they miss while at class)**
